

Dear Lawrence Township Resident:

Lawrence Township has received numerous complaints regarding yard waste and debris placed throughout our neighborhoods and local streets during the incorrect collection period. Residents have complained about the aesthetics of the neighborhoods and a potential safety hazard for motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians. Landscapers and residents routinely place brush at the curb soon after the Public Works crews have collected the zone, thereby leaving brush in the street for weeks at a time.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind residents of the following rules and regulations regarding brush collection in the Township of Lawrence:

- **Yard waste shall not be placed at the curb prior to your designated collection week.** Residents may place brush at the curb the weekend before their scheduled collection week.
- Yard waste and vegetative materials shall not be placed in an area of the street greater than four (4) feet in height. All branches shall be no greater than 5 feet in length.
- Tree limbs larger than 8 inches in diameter may not be disposed of through curbside collection.
- Stumps, dirt, grass, sod, pressure treated wood, stones, plywood, and construction material **will not** be collected.
- Yard waste shall not be placed within 10 feet from the nearest storm drain outlet.
- Yard Waste collection is suspended during the months of November and December for leaf collection. Yard waste may not be placed at the curb during the leaf collection program.

Brush may also be disposed of at the Ecological Facility at 3701 Princeton Pike. Please visit our website at www.lawrencetwp.com or contact the Public Works Department at (609) 587-1894 for information. Residents may also visit our website to ascertain their Brush Collection Zone, Garbage Collection Day, and Lot and Block Number. If you do not have access to a computer, please contact the Public Works Department for assistance.

Failure to comply with the regulations may result in the issuance of a summons which will subject you to fines and penalties.
