

Keefe Road Bridge Construction Project

Mercer County Department of Transportation

Please be advised that on or about Monday, November 6, 2017 bridge repairs will commence on the Structure No. 543.15, which is located on Keefe Road between Cold Soil Road and Yeger Drive in Lawrence Township. Repairs will consist of headwall repairs and installation of guiderail, necessitating a full 24/7 closure of Keefe Road. Construction will take place from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, and will be completed using in-house personnel. Mercer County anticipates construction will take approximately forty (40) calendar days to complete, weather permitting.

During construction, Keefe Road up to the bridge will be open to local residents but the bridge will be fully closed to through traffic. A detour will be posted directing through motorists to use Lawrenceville-Pennington Road, Federal City Road, Blackwell Road and Cold Soil Road.

Mercer County staff will post signs prior to the start date advising motorists of the upcoming bridge construction. We ask that you or a member of your staff please coordinate and notify affected local residents, businesses, emergency response, school transportation officials and any other pertinent groups, agencies or organizations that may be temporarily inconvenienced due to construction.

Please follow posted detours and expect delays.
