What You Need to Know about How Your Water Utility Is Working to Ensure High Water Quality

Our Water Distribution Technicians Will Conduct Targeted Flushing of Our Water Distribution System

Trenton Water Works (TWW), your drinking water supplier, will open fire hydrants in targeted areas of the city of Trenton, Ewing, Lawrence, and Hamilton Townships to flush water mains of stagnant water, an industry-standard process known as dead-end flushing, to elevate water quality throughout the water utility's water distribution system.

Our water distribution technicians will conduct this work from **July 16-26** in the evening between 8 p.m. and 12 a.m. to minimize any inconvenience to our customers. Our residential and commercial customers may experience brown water during this maintenance procedure. Therefore, we recommend customers open their cold-water faucets in the morning for approximately 10 minutes.
