#### Introduction of Ordinances

**10A**. An Ordinance amending and replacing Ordinance No. 1643-01. This amendment will permit households or business with exceptional circumstances, to be determined by the Municipal Manager, to exceed the two-hundred gallon limit for an additional cost per year.

**11A**. Ordinance 2291-18 amends the code of the Township by adding a new chapter entitled, "Traffic Control Standards: Requirements for Construction and Maintenance".
