

## NOTICE OF BID

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received and publicly opened and read at the Lawrence Township Municipal Building, 2207 Lawrence Road, Lawrence Township NJ 08648 at 10:00 a.m. prevailing time on Wednesday, November 15, 2023 for the project known as **Bid No. 23-17 Colonial Lake Hydroraking and Debris Removal.**

The bid shall provide for hydroraking within selected areas of Colonial Lake, a Municipal park owned by Lawrence Township located at 100 Bridge Drive, to remove approximately 750 cy of organic material. This work includes removal and disposal of all material as described in the specifications. The work under this contract includes removal of tree debris and other inorganic debris in the project area as set forth in the specifications. It is anticipated that a construction contract will be awarded on December 5, 2023, subject to the availability of funds in the 2023 Adopted Budget and 2023 Capital Plan. Construction shall commence on or about January 2, 2024. The completion of the project shall be sixty (60) working days from the date of receipt of the Notice to Proceed. All work must be completed by March 31, 2024.

Signed bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, addressed to the Engineering Department with the name of the project printed on the face of the envelope. Bids must be made on the proposal forms included with the bid specifications.

Bidders must comply with the regulations of **N.J.S.A.** 10:5-31 et seq. and **N.J.A.C.** 17:27 - 1 et seq.
