Dear Municipal Official:

JCP&L serves more than one million electric customers throughout New Jersey and has hundreds of miles of Transmission (TX) right-of-ways, which it is obligated under federal & state regulations to maintain in order to provide safe and reliable electric service to those customers. Maintaining these TX right-of-ways requires routine Transmission Vegetation Management (TVM) activities as determined by JCP&L, on a cyclical basis to help avoid service interruptions to JCP&L customers within your community (and elsewhere within JCP&L's service territory). Experience has shown that regular, diligent and professional vegetation management practices help to reduce the number of problems and outages that our customers experience.

Over the course of the 2024 calendar year, JCP&L contractors will be performing TVM activities in your community. Work may include: removal of incompatible vegetation within the TX right-of-way including the use of herbicides; routine trimming of limbs that encroach into the TX right-of-way including the possible use of an aerial saw; and removal of hazard priority trees that pose an imminent risk to transmission facilities.
