## STONY BROOK WATERSHED PLAN

Public Meeting: March 24, 2026 starting at 6 p.m.

The Municipalities of Hopewell Township, Pennington Borough, Lawrence Township and Princeton are working together to develop a single regional stormwater plan for the Stony Brook watersheds rather than developing separate plans in each town. This plan is required under their New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) stormwater permits, which mandate actions to reduce pollution and flooding. This permit is known as the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System Permit (MS4).

As part of this process, the municipalities are holding a regional public meeting to discuss the stormwater permit requirements, planning process, and to gather input.

The public is invited to attend the meeting to understand process and requirements and to provide information regarding flooding, water pollution, stream erosion, failing stormwater basins, and other stormwater concerns in their neighborhoods.
