IT'S TIME TO RENEW YOUR CAT LICENSE

September is cat license renewal month for Lawrence Township residents. Any cat over the age of seven months is required by law to be licensed. Cat license should be renewed by September 30, 2021.

Cat licenses are renewed in the Municipal Clerk's office. Proof of current rabies certification and proof of spaying or neutering (if applicable) must be presented when a license is purchased by mail or in person. The fee is \$11.00 if spayed or neutered and \$14.00 if not spayed or neutered. Effective December 1st a delinquent fee will be assessed in the amount of \$5.00 plus \$1.00 per month for each month delinquent.

Please complete the application and submit in person or by mail to the Municipal Clerk's Office with the appropriate fee and copy of a current rabies vaccination.

If you no longer have your cat(s), or if you have moved out of the township or to a new address, please contact the Municipal Clerk so we can correct our records.
