Programs

Project Graduation

Provides local high schoolers with fun, substance-free alternatives at graduation.

Peer Education Training


An afterschool peer leadership group which promotes a substance-free lifestyle.

Sticker Shock

A program which informs and reminds adults who may illegally purchase alcohol for minors of the consequences associated with assisting minors in accessing alcohol.

Parents Who Host

Provides community leaders and parents with tools to educate their peers about the legal, health, and safety issues associated with allowing minors to consume alcohol.
