## **2020 Internal Affairs Synopsis**

During 2020, the Officer Accountability Bureau investigated 57 complaints about officer conduct. This includes internally and externally generated complaints. Those complaints are broken down into the following categories: 14 complaints for demeanor, 27 for other rule violations, 5 alleging differential treatment, and 11 alleging other criminal violations. During 2020, a total of 58 investigations were completed. This total includes cases that were pending from the previous year. The dispositions of these complaints are: 14 were sustained, 14 were exonerated, 22 were not sustained, 3 were unfounded and 5 cases were administratively closed (this generally occurs when the complainant voluntarily requests that the complaint be withdrawn). As of the end of 2020, 8 cases are still under investigation.

In accordance with the New Jersey Attorney General's Guidelines on Internal Affairs, police agencies are required to publicly report when an officer has received a fine or suspension of 10 days or more. During 2020, no Lawrence Township Officer received a suspension of 10 days or more.

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
