Reopening Information and Guidelines

A MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR: Initially, the Senior Center will be open on a limited basis, at minimum capacity with access by pre-registration for Lawrence Residence only. With your safety in mind, we will be offering only a few classes and programs inside the building to offer opportunities for you to socialize and interact with your peers. Please know that we appreciate your time, patience and understanding while we move forward with a “Soft Reopening” of the Senior Center. We ask that you adhere to the guidelines below to maximize your safety. We have missed you tremendously and look forward to seeing you all very soon. Guidelines for Reopening

Temporary changes will be made at the Senior Center which will be strictly enforced upon reopening on Wednesday, July 7, 2021.

- The Senior Center building will be open for limited classes and programs only; and we ask you to plan to remain in the building within the time allotted for the activity. Participation in activities will require registration in advance by calling the Senior Center at 609-844-7048.
- Temperature Checks will be taken daily before entering the building. Anyone with a fever of 100.4 or who has recently had a fever of 100.4 will not be allowed to enter the building.
- Everyone entering or moving around in the building must properly wear a face covering / mask at all times. You may remove the mask once you are situated and at a safe distance from others.
- Please wash and/or sanitize your hands before entering any designated rooms and frequently while in the building and after coming in contact with others.
- The only rooms that are available for use are the computer room, game room, multi-purpose rooms, and bathrooms, please refrain from wandering around in the building or entering the office. The reception area would be the point of contact for all of your needs at this time.
- For your maximum safety, in order to implement social distancing, we will only be able to accommodate up to thirty (30) in the multi- purpose room; three in the computer room; 8 in the game room and 3 at a time in our senior van.
- No food is permitted to be brought into the building aside from water, coffee and tea. Lite Refreshments will be served by staff only during our morning and afternoon socialization programs.
- Upon entering the building you will be issued an identification card and senior center lanyard holding the ID in place. When you leave for the day we will collect your ID and lanyard and return to you on your next visit.
- When utilizing the rest rooms the lanyard will be placed outside of the bathroom on a hook. Only two individuals are allowed access into the restrooms at one time.
- The Grab and Go lunches will continue to operate during our soft reopening and meals will be distributed outdoors. Lunches are not permitted to be consumed in the building and pre-registration is required to reserve your meal.
- Limited space is available to participate in the Choraliers and Italian class as existing class list will be given priority. The computer room is available for prescheduled appointments not to exceed one hour per session. Due to capacity limits, participants of the computer room, socialization programs, and prize bingos will be placed on a wait list for the following week or event in order to be sure all interested parties are given an opportunity to participate.
