

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE II
OF THE LAWRENCE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
ENTITLED "DOGS"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Lawrence, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 4, Article II, of the Lawrence Township Administrative Code entitled "Dogs" be and is hereby amended by the addition of the following paragraph.

1. Sec. 4-3a

Any person other than a visually handicapped handler of a guide dog who has charge of a dog shall be responsible for the prompt and efficient removal and sanitary disposition of the feces of the dog from any public place or any private place unless otherwise expressly permitted by the owner. Where the violation shall occur in the absence of an identifiable handler, each person who shall be an owner of the dog shall be deemed to be in violation of this ordinance. Violations of this ordinance shall be prosecuted upon the complaint timely filed by any person or by any officer or employee of the Township of Lawrence and shall subject the violator to the fines and penalties prescribed generally for the violation of ordinances under Section 1-6 of the Township Code.

2.. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days following final adoption thereof, in accordance with law.
