## Lawrence Township is Awarded a Silver Level Certification by Sustainable Jersey for 2022

In 2022, Lawrence Township once again achieved Sustainable Jersey certification at the silver-level with 505 points. Lawrence Township is one of 81 municipalities that have attained certification in 2022. Certified towns are an outstanding group of municipalities making important contributions toward the long-term goal of a sustainable New Jersey, and world.

To become Sustainable Jersey certified, Lawrence Township completed a balance of the rigorous program's sustainability actions. Lawrence Township did five priority actions and completed 42 actions in 13 different categories. Approved actions include brownfields planning, brownfields assessment and investigation, vulnerable populations identification for emergencies, municipal on-site solar system, purchase of alternative fuel vehicles, public electric vehicle charging infrastructure, local business support, prescription drug safety, tree maintenance programs, and complete streets activities.
