Lawrence Township to Host Master Plan Town Hall Meeting on June 11

LAWRENCE TOWNSHIP, N.J. — Lawrence Township will host a town hall-style public meeting on the status of the township's Master Plan on **Thursday, June 11, at 7 p.m.** at the **Lawrence Senior Center, 30 Darrah Lane East, Lawrenceville, NJ 08648.**

The meeting is intended to inform residents about the status of the Master Plan process and provide an opportunity for members of the public to ask questions, share comments and offer feedback.

"The Master Plan should be the reflection of a shared vision for Lawrence Township that is shaped by the entire community," said Mayor Christopher Bobbitt. "This town hall is an opportunity for residents to understand where the process is, to ask questions of the plan, and to offer their insights to what our collective future could look like."

"The Council is very happy to be able to host this important meeting to update the public on an important issue facing our town, The Master Plan is an important planning tool and the Council wants to hear from and have reflected back as many voices as possible. We are looking forward to this informative and productive conversation."

Participants will be able to ask questions or provide public comment during the meeting. While the panel may be able to answer some questions during the event, not every question can be answered immediately. Residents with specific questions they would like addressed are encouraged to submit them in writing ahead of time.

A sign-in sheet will be available at the meeting for residents who wish to speak. Speakers will be called in the order they sign in and will have **five minutes** to make their comments. The panel may respond depending on the content of the question or public comment.

The Lawrence Township Master Plan serves as a guiding document for land use, development, preservation, transportation and other long-term planning decisions. The June 11 meeting is part of the township's continued effort to keep the public informed and engaged throughout the process.
