CONFIRMED TORNADO

The National Weather Service in Mounty Holly has confirmed that an EF-0 strength land spout tornado with maximum wind speed of 80 mph, had touched down in Lawrence Township on Friday, June 14, 2024 at approximately 6:00pm.

Damage was sustained to trees along Johnson Rd (just north of Texas Ave) behind the Conoco Gas Station. Additionally, the Circle Branch Post Office (2601 Brunswick Pike, Lawrenceville) sustained damage to the roof and several vehicles in the parking lot were overturned by the tornado. Fortis Institute (2572 Brunswick Pike, Lawrenceville) also sustained significant damage to the roof and solar panels.

Representatives surveying the damage from the National Weather Service – Mount Holly were assisted by the NJ State Police Office of Emergency Management, Mercer County Office of Emergency Management and the Lawrence Township Police Department.

No injuries have been reported as a result of this tornado.

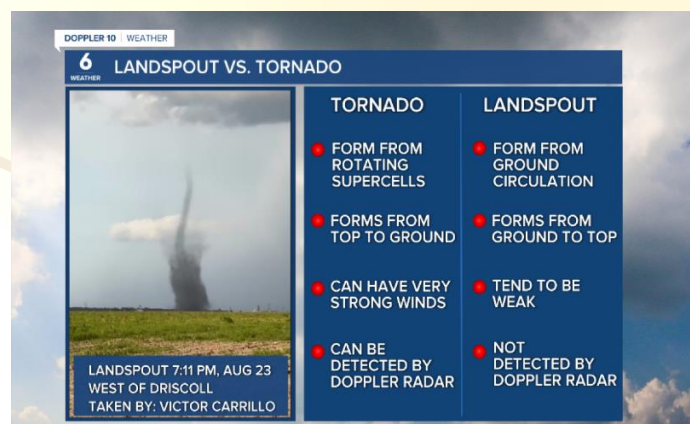
